Rules and Regulations Jump Heaven

Always:

- Use Jump Heaven jumping socks
- Wear sportswear
- One person per trampoline at a time
- Spread your legs and bend your knees as you jump
- When you bounce, land carefully on both feet or on your bottom
- Pay attention to others and always give priority to younger children
- Check that there are no other people on the airbag before jumping
- Exit immediately after jumping onto the airbag
- Empty your pockets before jumping
- Jump in the middle of the trampoline
- Jumping onto the airbag by doing somersaults is dangerous, anyone who wants to perform them is aware of the risk involved
- Follow all Jump Heaven rules and adhere to the guidelines provided by Jump Heaven employees

Never:

- Jump or land on the padding
- Run in the park
- Land head-first or neck-first
- Bring personal items into the amusement area (watches, necklaces, belts, earrings, cell phones, etc.)
- Enter the amusement area with food and beverages
- Enter the amusement area with chewing gum and candy
- Jump after drinking alcoholic beverages
- Jump into the sponge pit
- Play in a violent manner
- Hang onto the basketball hoop or backboard
- Do flips on the trampolines
- Do more than one flip onto the airbag
- Cling to or lean on any safety net

During opening hours, children between the ages of 7 and 17 years old may enter the amusement area only with a Jump Heaven waiver signed by a parent/guardian.

Children between the ages of 3 and 6 years old may enter the amusement area only if accompanied by a parent/guardian who will accompany them on all park rides.

Adults are responsible for all damages caused by children and minors in their care.

Guests are responsible for the key to the lockers, in case of loss of key or damage, they are required to pay €10 for the replacement of the key.

Jump Heaven is not responsible for money and valuables deposited inside the amusement area or locker area, even if the lockers are locked.

Jump Heaven is not responsible for any damage to persons or property, even if caused by improper use of spaces, materials, equipment.

Jump Heaven has the right to refuse entry to the structure:

Persons in a state of intoxication.

Aggressive persons who threaten the safety of other guests.

Jump Heaven has the right to expel those who:

Do not comply with the Jump Heaven rules and regulations.

Behave aggressively, improperly, use vulgar words.

Do not respect the rules or recommendations of the Jump Heaven staff.

Users are required to wear entry bracelets, which are issued by the cashier after paying the entry fee.

Knowledge of these rules releases Jump Heaven from any and all liability.

Users are required to strictly adhere to these regulations and those that may be issued by the staff on duty.
